APRIL 15 - Student Follow-Up Information Due to KSDE - Instructions Linked [HERE](#)

APRIL 30 - Equipment, Supplies, Software, Subscriptions, and Computing Devices Requests for 2021-22 [FORM](#) Due to Greenbush (Please note that allocations/budgets are not available yet for FY22. However, we anticipate your budget will be similar to last year, so we suggest working off of that number. Please request additional items in case the allotment is more. ASK FOR MORE!)

MAY 21 - KCAN records should be submitted in KIDS for Excel in CTE certifications. This should be completed by the designated KIDS representative for the school or district. (785-296-7935 - KIDS Help Desk)

JULY 1 - FY2022 Perkins Grant Year Begins. FY22 funds may only be spent on **pre-approved** activities/purchases that take place between July 1, 2021, and June 30, 2022.

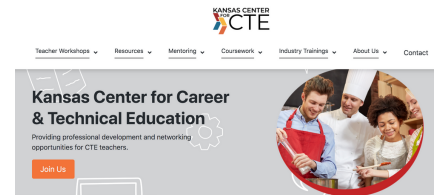

AUGUST - Greenbush Training Camp - FREE

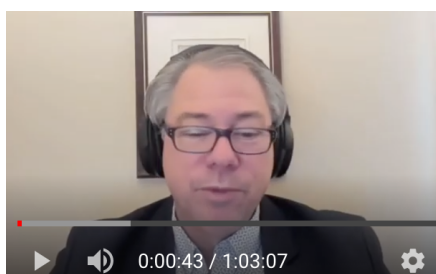

CTE Conference videos, resources, college credit still available

Just a reminder that if you registered for the virtual February CTE Conference, you still have access to over 100 recorded sessions and a plethora of resources until August 25, 2021. When you go to our [conference website](#), resources are linked to each respective session. Registrants can access the recordings in three ways:

- (1) Go to "Agenda" on the left side and then search the session you are looking for by the presenter's name, session title, or keywords. Once the session options appear, simply click on the session title to access the recording and all resources.
- (2) Go to "Agenda" and click on a specific date if you know when the session was held live.
- (3) Go to "Video Gallery" on the left side to see all of the session recordings at a glance and view straight from there.

HOW

- Attend at least four hours of sessions that will be available until August 25, 2021.
- Following each session, complete the Certificate of Completion form provided by the presenter.
- Send to lis.mccartney@psu.edu in one email.
- The certificates you would like to receive for college credit (see chart above for the number of hours needed for each credit amount).
- Upon receiving the certificate, you will reply with the required college credit form with instructions on where to send payment.
- College credit is \$99.50 for half an hour and \$199 for an hour. You may pay with a check or credit card. If you use a credit card, there is a 2.75% convenience fee.
- College credit forms and payment must be received on or before August 25, 2021.
- After submission of forms, scores will be posted to your PSU online transcript.
