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Pathway application assistance offered via recorded tutorials

Time is precious, and now more so than ever! So, when it comes to completing your pathway applications for the 2021-22 school year, here are some helpful resources that you can review on your own time. Also, please reach out to me for a one-on-one session with your district if you want more personalized assistance.

~ If you are adding new courses to existing approved pathways, OR you are adding new pathways next year, those new 21-22 pathway courses need to be submitted for approval in the KCCMS system by **FEBRUARY 1**.

The application window to submit ALL pathways for the 2021-22 school year closes on MARCH 1. Remember, all pathways need to be submitted for approval, including existing pathways that were previously approved by KSDE.
