- 1. The certificates you would like to redeem for college credit (see chart above for the number of hours needed for each credit amount)
- 2. Upon receiving the certificates, Lisa will reply with the required college credit forms with instructions on where to send payment.

• College credit is \$59.50 for half an hour and \$109 for an hour. You may pay with a check or credit card. If you use a credit card, there is a 2.75% convenience fee.

- College credit forms and payment must be received on or before August 25, 2021.
- After submission of forms, courses will be posted to your PSU online transcript.


