KSDE has released three Perkins Reserve Grants intended to support "Strengthening CTE through Strategic Planning for Improvement" through a series of collaborative opportunities with KSDE Regional Education Program consultants. This would include collaboration with the Work-Based Learning initiative as a part of the Kansas strategic priorities for CTE. The [Implementation Grant](#) is only for districts that previously received the Improvement Grant, and the Work-Based Learning Grant is only for the six original WBL pilot districts.

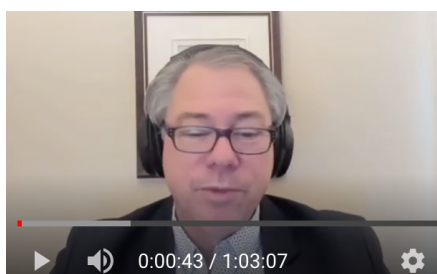
The \$10,000 [Improvement Grant](#), however, is for any district that has not received a strategic grant in the past. This grant emphasizes professional development, data digging, team building, and networking. Districts would be expected to build a team of at least six educators (including Administration, Counseling, Special Populations representation, CTE teachers and at least one non-CTE teacher) who would be involved in such opportunities as the IPS Professional Learning Network, WBL Coordinator Training, CTE Conferences, etc., and the grant money would be used toward substitute fees, instructor fees and PD registration. Districts can also team up and apply for the grant together. Successful completers of this grant phase would be eligible to apply for an Implementation Grant for professional development and/or possibly equipment in the subsequent year.

HOW

- Attend at least four hours of sessions that will be available until August 25, 2021.
- Following each session, complete the Certificate of Completion form provided by the presenter.
- Send to lis.mccain@psu.edu, in one email.
- The certificates you would like to request for college credit (see chart above for the number of hours needed for each credit amount).
- Upon receiving the certificates, Lisa will reply with the required college credit forms with instructions on where to send payment.
- College credit is \$99.50 for half an hour and \$199 for an hour. You may pay with a check or credit card. If you use a credit card, there is a 2.75% convenience fee.
- College credit forms and payment must be received on or before August 25, 2021.
- After submission of forms, courses will be posted to your PSU online transcript.
